Clarity about what law school for Gabe and future jobs is also needed. 2. Daniel is training hard as he prepares to try out for a special ops unit with the air force. Keep him in prayer for wisdom, grace and peace as he pursues this career/ministry. He turns 18 In 2 days. 3. We ask prayer for wisdom, guidance and provision as Mark believes this is his last year at SCS. He desires to be back ministering with Chinese/Taiwanese in a more full-time way in evangelism, discipleship and church-encouragement. This will involve more traveling. Open doors in various places where large pockets of Chinese are have been suggested but clear guidance and financial provision is needed. Mark still remember these words by Hudson Taylor he read as a young high school student as God was calling him to reach Chinese people: "God's work done in God's way will never lack God's supply." Laura will continue teaching Mandarin part time at SCS and work with int. students. Our home-base will be Fort Worth for the near future. 4. Carson, one of Mark's bible students, told Mark last week that he is heading to Japan and then to Italy for short term travel. He has had an interest/desire in being a missionary to Japan for a while. He is only a sophomore in high school but loves the Lord dearly and we rejoice in our times with Carson these 2 years. Finley, another of Mark's students, is in Guatemala now on a missions trip too this Thanksgiving. Keep her growth in our Lord in prayer. 7. Another 9th grade boy Matthew (He has "the mother of all mullets" by the way and proud of it) wants to be a pastor/missionary. Pray for their life-long Holy Spirit impact for mission trips internationally and locally in the Spring too.

We again want to thank each of you for your many prayers, partnership and provision for this work that God has given us. We pray for you in the same way. We are in need of His touch in our lives moment by moment; day by day. He is so good and kind! Lord, help us walk worthy of You for You are worthy! There are so many unreached people groups, limited access countries and areas where the gospel, Christ-centered churches and ministries don't exist or are in short supply (and needs here too) as you know. May our hearts still beat for these people groups and areas. 2 Corinthians 5 challenges us constantly about the fact that we are ambassadors for Christ and that our world needs to hear & see Christ lived out in our lives.
